In God's name. I Hugh Tingle of Craven County in
the Carolina Yeoman. Being extant and weak in Body but of perfect
mind to God for it calling to mind the mortality of mans Body as know-
ing to make ordain and Constitute this my last will and Testament
principally and first of all I Recommend my Soul into the hands of
God to be buried in a Christian manner at the Discretion of my Executors
worldly Goods as it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life
and in the following

I Give my Negro boy Named Dick to gether with all the money
I possess and enjoyed and his heirs for ever — it being his full
will and that he shall have no Claim to any other part whatsoever
and my Negro Girl Named Jenny to be fully and enjoyed and his
heirs

I Give and Grant all my Rite title and property to a tract of Land
containing 100 Acres on the North Side of Bay River with all the apper-
tances and Draper in the Exchange thereof with its appertenance by them
to be fully and freely to be possessed and enjoyed and their heirs

I Give my Negro Boy Named Milbee to be possessed and enjoyed
and my Negro Girl Rachel should die leaving no heir of her body that then
the produce to be Equally Divided among my other Children
Plantations and Tract of Land whereon I now live with with fifty
Acres and the end thereof with all their privileges and appertenances

I Give my Negro Girl Named Titus a Negro Girl Named Mary and also
my working Tools of all sorts by him to be fully and freely pos-
sessed in the manner a pair of Cattle in Hand mill Sower
Hatch and Chattles and Credits I Leave to be Equally Divided
only accepted: & that it be Divided by two men Chosen by the
Sons of the Deceased Joseph and Gideon Joint and coequal Executors of
this will. Reserving Disanuling and Disallowing all and every
equally whatsoever by me in any wife heretofore made
