The Endnotes included are not all of the records that pertain to that individual, but have some clarifying information. A full list of records searched is included as a Bibliography which is several pages long. I apologize in some instances of not giving full sources, but my hard drive on my computer "crashed" and scrambled a lot of my notes and I've been six months rebuilding my information on more than 28,000 names, which only about 3,000 are Tingles. Then too, when I don't give a call number, I may have used the microfilm or book in a library in Idaho, Arizona, Utah, Oregon, Texas, Pennsylvania, Colorado, etc. I have made two trips to Kentucky and Maryland before I found Littleton Tingle in Delaware. FHL# stands for the Family History Library in Salt Lake City, Utah, which has branches across the world. If there is a GS# it is an old number for the Family History Library which I've never gone back and updated. When I've used original records, I sometimes included the FHL# because I wanted to double check the records I copied. I also want to apologize to anyone I owe a letter to but due to severe family problems, I was unable to do anything but try to cope with life, work, and raise my family as a single parent and I lost touch with everyone except my immediate family. I had these families put together in 1982 but then my personal life took a nose dive and I'm just getting back on track.

He lived next to Elisha Bishop and all of Elisha Bishop's children could read and write; which leads me to believe that the tutor they hired must have taught both families. According to the History of Henry County Kentucky, there were no rural schools and that the more wealthy families hired tutors for their children. The land that Littleton Tingle and Elisha Bishop owned is still owned by their descendants; and it's still a rural area but beautiful.

⁶Littleton and John were brothers. Mabel Lansberry who is a descendant of Littleton married her cousin Claude Tingle. Claude is a descendant of Kindle who's father was probably John.

⁷ Last appears in 1848 Tax Records Henry County, Kentucky, In 1849, Jeddediah Tingle is listed as administer of Littleton Tingle Estate.
