estate in 1838, two years after she was married.16

Sally Radford may have been the daughter born between 1810 and 1815. She was unmarried when she sold her share of her father's estate in 1835. She also lived in Hendricks County, Indiana at that time.

Huldah Radford was born 11 May 1816 and married Squire Watkins in September 1834 in Henry County. Squire was born 11 May 1816. The couple had a farm in Henry County near Smithfield. Their children included the three daughters and one son that were named in Squire's will: Sarah F. VanClive, born ca. 1836; John Evan Watkins, born 1837; Mary E. Blades, born ca. 1841; and Charlotte Watkins, born ca. 1854. Squire died on 19 November 1872. Huldah died on 23 Jul 1892. Their graves are marked in the Smithfield Cemetery with matching marble headstones near the graves of Sharlotte and Will Bohannon, and John and Louisa Radford. Also nearby are the graves of "Father" John Evan Watkins, 1837-1926, and "Mother" Rachel Watkins 1839-1890.

# LAURA JONES TINGLE BIBLE

At a recent sale of the estate of Henry Gividen three Bibles were withheld from the sale asthe auctioneer, Ricky Timberlake, will not sell Bibles, which we think is a wonderful practice. The administrators of the estate, Charles and Betsy Carpenter, didn't know what to do with them. An auction assistant for Mr. Timberlake, and member of the Henry County Historical Society, Charles A. Miller and his wife, Marguerite, suggested they donate them to the Historical Society. This was an admirable suggestion, as each Bible contained family genealogy, which we share with you here. We thank the Carpenters and the Millers for their donation.

The first Bible is black leather with the name Laura Tingle embossed in gold on the front. The front page states: "Presented to Mother by Mary Leslie Dec. 25, 1947." Though second Bible, which follows contains duplicate information, also contains additional names, as well as, maiden names and middle names that do not appear in this Bible. For that reason we are listing them both in their entirety.
